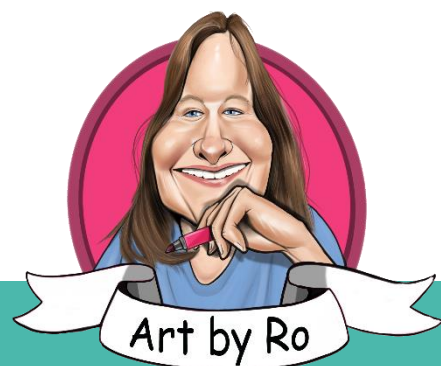
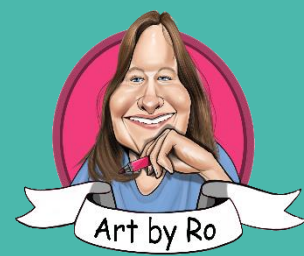

Stage 2: Color Harmony

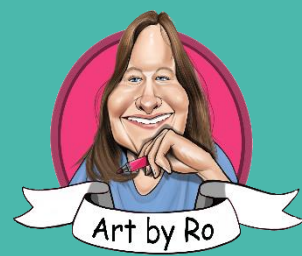
- Choose the right colors

- Themes

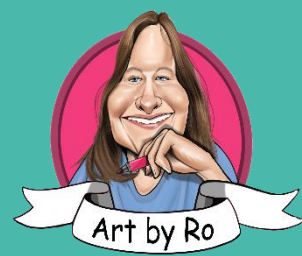

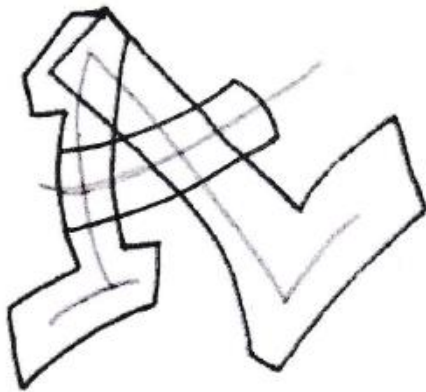

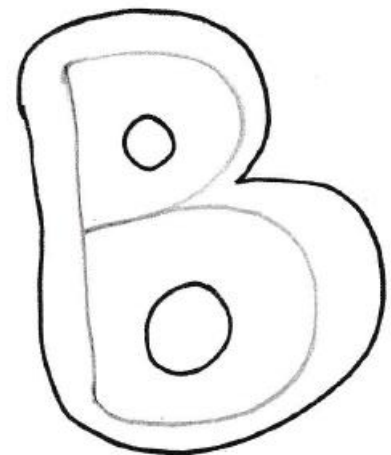
Lettering Styles

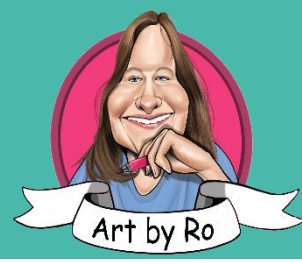




Lettering Accents
